Here slope slopes inclined on the southeast side and deep loess soil ensure best maturity grades. Vinification: Selection of the best positioned grapes, rubbed, crushed, short maceration time, gently pressed in pneumatic press, temperature-controlled fermentation in stainless steel tank. Then matured in stainless steel tank. Serving suggestion: Serve cool (10-12 °C), all-rounder that will accompany a variety of dishes well: numerous cold dishes, from light meat to everything baked.
