The Hager Rot is a blend of Zweigelt, St. Laurent and Pinot Noir. This high-quality blend was created through the harmonious interplay of these red wine varieties, the special care of the vineyard and the right accompaniment of the wine in the cellar. The Pinot Noir in particular requires the highest quality locations (barren, flint-containing, gneiss weathering soils with southern slope orientation). The grapes grow at 350-400m above sea level on clay and mica slate soil. After thorough selection by hand and spontaneous fermentation, the Hager Rot was allowed to mature in small used oak barrels for 18 months and was then filled into the bottle. The Hager Rot is a relatively light, yet full-bodied, fruity red wine with soft tannins and a long finish. It goes well with game dishes, cheese and is also a pleasure on its own.
